

GOOD AND FAITHFUL SERVANT?

JUDGEMENT/GIVING AN ACCOUNT TO GOD

- “He will judge everyone according to what they have done.” **Romans 2:6 (NLT)**
- “So then, each of us will give an account of ourselves to God.” **Romans 14:12 (NIV)**
- “For we must all appear and be revealed as we are before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive [his pay] according to what he has done in the body, whether good or evil [considering what his purpose and motive have been, and what he has achieved, been busy with, and given himself and his attention to accomplishing].” **2 Corinthians 5:10 (AMP)**

JUDGEMENT/GIVING AN ACCOUNT TO GOD

- “For the Son of Man will come with his angels in the glory of his Father and will judge all people according to their deeds.” **Matthew 16:27 (NLT)**
- “I said to myself, “In due season God will judge everyone, both good and bad, for all their deeds.” **Ecclesiastes 3:17 (NLT)**
- “God will judge us for everything we do, including every secret thing, whether good or bad.” **Ecclesiastes 12:14 (NLT)**

- **To Conform Only to God's Values & Not to The World's Standards**
 - (Romans 12:2 – Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.)

- **DON'T GET IT TWISTED!**
- **SALVATION AND HEAVEN BY JESUS...NOT BY WORKS**
- **“God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.” Ephesians 2:8-9 (NLT)**

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- Performance evaluations tell me how I'm doing, what I'm doing well, and where I can do better. I can get rehired, promoted, and/or rewarded based on these reviews

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- **EVALUATED AND REWARDED BY GOD – 12 VERSUS**
- “For no one can lay any foundation other than the one we already have—Jesus Christ. Anyone who builds on that foundation may use a variety of materials—gold, silver, jewels, wood, hay, or straw. But on the judgment day, fire will reveal what kind of work each builder has done. The fire will show if a person’s work has any value. If the work survives, that builder will receive a reward. But if the work is burned up, the builder will suffer great loss. The builder will be saved, but like someone barely escaping through a wall of flames.” 1 Corinthians 3:11-15 (NLT)

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- **EVALUATED AND REWARDED BY GOD**
- “He repays people according to their deeds. He treats people as they deserve.” **Job 34:11 (NLT)**
- “Great are your purposes and mighty are your deeds. Your eyes are open to the ways of all mankind; you reward each person according to their conduct and as their deeds deserve.” **Jeremiah 32:19 (NIV)**

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- **EVALUATED AND REWARDED BY GOD**
- “Yes, the Sovereign LORD is coming in power. He will rule with a powerful arm. See, he brings his reward with him as he comes.” **Isaiah 40:10 (NLT)**
- “But I, the LORD, search all hearts and examine secret motives. I give all people their due rewards, according to what their actions deserve.”

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- **EVALUATED AND REWARDED BY GOD**
- “...Then all the churches will know that I am he who searches hearts and minds, and I will repay each of you according to your deeds.” **Revelation 2:23 (NIV)**
- “Look, I am coming soon, bringing my reward with me to repay all people according to their deeds.” **Revelation 22:12 (NLT)**

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- **EVALUATED AND REWARDED BY GOD**
- “I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.” **Philippians 3:14 (NIV)**
- “He thought it was better to suffer for the sake of Christ than to own the treasures of Egypt, for he was looking ahead to his great reward.” **Hebrews 11:26 (NLT)**

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- **EVALUATED AND REWARDED BY GOD**
- “The one who plants and the one who waters have one purpose, and they will each be rewarded according to their own labor.” **1 Corinthians 3:8 (NIV)**
- “And when the Great Shepherd appears, you will receive a crown of never-ending glory and honor.” **1 Peter 5:4 (NLT)**

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- We are receiving a performance evaluation from Jesus, even now
 - Jesus gives us a “peer review”. He evaluates our performance and intercedes to God on our behalf
 - “Who then is the one who condemns? No one. Christ Jesus who died—more than that, who was raised to life—is at the right hand of God and is also interceding for us.” **Romans 8:34 (NIV)**

PERFORMANCE EVALUATION

- We will receive a performance evaluation by others
 - we'll get feedback from those whose lives we've touched, influenced or impacted. We'll have people lined up in heaven waiting to say "Thank You", as we get to see the impact of the contributions that we made
 - "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us." **Hebrews 12:1 (NLT)**
