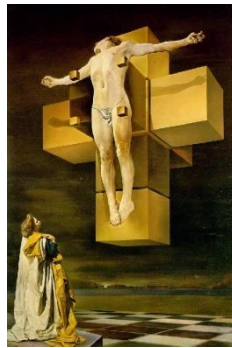


Thursday

Thursday: Gethsemane-- the Betrayal and Arrest <Mt 26:36-56; Mk 14:32-53; Lk 22:39-53; Jn 18:1-12> Agony in the Garden Betrayal by Judas-- Jesus Arrested

About midnight, Trial before the Sanhedrin (<Mt 26:57-75; 27:1-10; Mk 14:53-72; 15:1; Lk 22:54-71; Jn 18:12-27>; compare <Acts 1:18-19>) a) Before Annas and Caiaphas--the Unjust Judgment

1. An illegal session
2. A morning confirmation
b) The Threefold Denial
c) Remorse and Suicide of Judas
Friday, probably between 6 a.m. and 7 a.m. Trial before Pilate <Mt 27:2,11-31; Mk 15:1-20; Lk 23:1-25; Jn 18:28-40; 19:1-16>

Palm Sunday

Palm Sunday: The Entry into Jerusalem <Mt 21:1-11; Mk 11:1-11; Lk 19:29-44; Jn 12:12-19> Jesus weeping over Jerusalem <Lk 19:41-44>

Monday

Monday: Cursing of the Fig Tree-- Second Cleansing of Temple 21:12-22; <Mk 11:12-26; Lk 19:45-48>

Tuesday

This is Jesus' most busiest day of the week, filled with parables, discourses, incidents, so numerous and impressive, yet tragically in the prophesy of the cross to come. As you read it may oppress the mind in grasping how one day could embrace it all. It was the last day of the appearance of Jesus in the temple

Wednesday: A Day of Retirement (<Jn 12:36>) Tuesday or Wednesday: An Atmosphere of Plotting-- Judas and the Priests <Mt 26:1-5,14-16; Mk 14:1-2,10-11; Lk 22:1-6>

Thursday

Thursday: The Last Supper (<Mt 26:17-35; Mk 14:12-31; Lk 22:7-38; Jn 13>; compare <1 Cor 11:23-25>)

- a) The Preparation: On "the first day of unleavened bread"-- Passover (14th of Nisan)
- b) Dispute about Precedence-- Washing of the Disciples' Feet-- Departure of Judas
- c) The Lord's Supper
- d) The Last Discourses-- Intercessory Prayer
